

CQJ - 4 - DAY CRUISE

The romantic Rhine Valley

STRASBOURG – KOBLENZ – RUDESHEIM – SPEYER OR MANNHEIM - STRASBOURG

DAY 1: STRASBOURG - KOBLENZ

Leave Strasbourg (river basin – 3b rue du Havre) by coach at 8.00 AM in order to reach Koblenz around 12.30 PM. Lunch is included in a local restaurant before boarding the ship at 2.00 PM. Time is allowed to settle comfortably in your cabins. Then we invite you to accompany your ship's guide on a walking tour of the old part of the city. Return back to the ship for dinner on board. Enjoy a free evening in Koblenz. There is also the possibility of boarding at 6.00 PM. Overnight is in Koblenz.

DAY 2 : KOBLENZ - RUDESHEIM

Breakfast is served while cruising along the most beautiful stretch of the romantic Rhine River between Koblenz and Rudesheim. Romantic castles are perched high on the hills that overlook the lush vineyards and the quaint wine villages. The legendary Lorelei rock begins the journey into the middle Rhine. Lunch is served on board before arriving in Rudesheim at around 4.00 PM. There is some free time to discover the town or you may leave on an optional guided tour on a miniature train before calling in at a local cellar to taste the wine. Then the tour visits the musical instrument museum. Dinner will be served on board. You are invited to spend the evening discovering the famous and lively Drosselstrasse with its open air taverns and dancehalls. Overnight is in Rudesheim.

DAY 3 : RUDESHEIM – MANNHEIM OR SPEYER

We get an early start cruising up the Rhine towards Speyer, passing the towns of Wiesbaden, Nierstein, Worms and Mannheim along the way. Breakfast and lunch are served on board. An optional guided tour of Heidelberg is offered with a visit to select parts of the castle and the town centre. Dinner is served on board followed by a gala evening. Departure towards Strasbourg takes place later that evening for an overnight sailing.

DAY 4 : SPEYER OR MANNHEIM - STRASBOURG

Breakfast is served on board. Arrival in Strasbourg is around 09.00 AM with disembarkation.
